

# BURNHAM COMPANY OF ARCHERS BEGINNERS COURSE APPLICATION FORM

Burnham Company of Archers welcomes anybody who wants to try archery with a view to taking up the sport & joining our club. On the beginners course our instructors will teach you the correct shooting technique & ensure you know how to shoot safely within a club environment.

Courses are a minimum of 12 hours tuition usually spread over 6 sessions and are held at our home ground.

You must complete your form and have your place confirmed by the club prior to the course starting. Payment is required to book your place, cheques will not be banked until your date has been confirmed.

A course consists of weekly 2 hour sessions. If it is necessary to cancel a lesson due to bad weather an alternative session will be provided. If you know in advance that you will miss a particular week (e.g. if you are on holiday), then it can be made up later at the coaches discretion. If you are unable to attend a particular lesson please let us know beforehand. We cannot accept beginners into the Club unless they have received a minimum of 12 hours coaching and have received their completion certificate

#### Cost

The fee for each course is - £60.

#### **Juniors**

We allow juniors of age  $\underline{8}$  years and above to apply to join the beginner's course. However, acceptance of each junior on the course is subject to the approval of the Head Coach/Instructor.

Juniors must be accompanied by parents, or parentally approved guardians, at all times when shooting.

# **Equipment**

We provide all the equipment for the course. Please, **do not buy any equipment** yourselves. If you join the club after the course, we can offer bows for hire for a limited time (please be aware they may be required for other beginners to use during their courses), or offer advice to help you purchase your own equipment.

# Clothing

You should wear comfortable but close-fitting clothing. If it's chilly it's better to wear several thin layers rather than one bulky one & perhaps bring a woolly hat. In particular it's important that you don't wear jumpers or jackets with baggy sleeves as bow strings tend to catch on them & spoil your shot! Shoes must be closed toe – no sandals.

### Where

Outdoors (from April – October) at the BASC Ground, Stoddens Road, Burnham on Sea.

Please note we do have access to toilet facilities within the BASC camping area, these include disabled facilities.

All coaching and shooting will be strictly in accordance with ARCHERY GB rules of shooting, regulations and practice.

Burnham Company of Archers retain the right to refuse further access to the beginner's course if students persistently disobey the safety instructions or the rules of shooting.
